

SUPER READER HERO CAPE DIRECTIONS

(For East Side Learning Center)

Supplies Needed

Fabric: 7/8 yard of 42" wide fabric will yield 2 capes

Double Fold Bias Tape - 1/2 package of commercial tape

Thread to match or contrast

Assembly

1. Place pattern on fabric with center line on straight of grain; pin in place.
2. Cut along all edges of pattern through the 2 fabric layers.
3. Bind raw edges with double fold bias tape, sewing neckline edge first.
4. For closure either add velcro to each end or extend bias tape 8-10" per side for ties.
5. If doing bias ties, be sure to enclose neckline bias edges when sewing the sides and extension.

Please Note: Each cape should take less than 30 minutes to make, once you learn the process. East Side Learning Center will mail you a pattern for a small (Kindergarten and First grade) or large (Second and Third grade) cape. We can also provide you with supplies or you can purchase your own. If you purchase your own, we will provide you will a donation form for tax write off purposes. We suggest using any kind of cotton or cotton blend fabric in a variety of patterns or colors that all genders would appreciate- whatever is on sale is fine!
